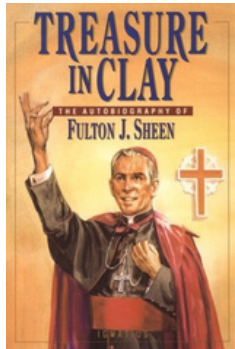


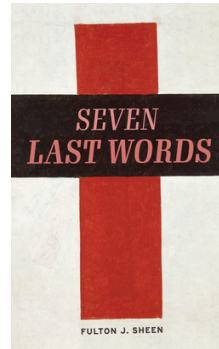

Treasure in Clay

In this assignment, you will explore the life, struggles, faith, and mission of Archbishop Fulton Sheen through his autobiography, Treasure in Clay. You will reflect on how God works through ordinary people to accomplish extraordinary things.



Seven Last Words

In this assignment, you will reflect on Archbishop Fulton Sheen's meditations on the final words of Jesus on the Cross. Through reading, writing, and personal reflection, you will explore how Christ's words still speak to Christians today.

Choose ONE theme from the book and write a one-page reflection:

Include:

- How Sheen demonstrated this theme
- Give one example from the book
- Describe what modern Catholics can learn from his example
- Reflect on how this theme applies to your own life

Optional Extension

Research the Bible verse behind the title Treasure in Clay (2 Corinthians 4:7).

Then answer:

- What does this Scripture mean?
- How did Fulton Sheen live out this verse in his ministry and life?

Choose ONE of the Seven Last Words and write a one-page reflection.

Include:

- What Jesus said
- What Fulton Sheen teaches about this saying
- Why this message is important today
- How this saying can apply to your own life

Optional Extension:

Research how Fulton Sheen's reflections on the Cross connect to:

- Holy Week
- Eucharistic Adoration
- Missionary work
- Suffering in the modern world
